The Wasatch County Fire District is responsible for checking for the location of fire hydrants and approval of fire access roads.

The Fire District may require installation of fire sprinklers in your structure if any or all of the following exists:

1. Your access is not year-round and has grades above 10 percent
2. Response time is hindered or obstructed in any way by poor access, lack of access maintenance and/or percent of grade.
3. Your structure exceeds 3,600 square feet total – including the basement, garage, and other miscellaneous areas within the structure.
4. Any lot or acreage that has no fire protection.

Fire Sprinklers WILL BE REQUIRED in the following areas of Wasatch County:

All of the Strawberry area including Daniels Summit
Timber Lakes Subdivision
Diamond Bar X and surrounding areas
Wolf Creek Ranch and surrounding areas
All of the Jordanelle Basin area
Interlaken and Snake Creek areas
Oak Haven, Swiss Alpine and surrounding areas
ANY AND ALL WILD LAND INTERFACE AREAS.

In areas where propane is used, a **Propane Permit** is required. The permit cost is **\$100.00** for above ground tanks and **\$250.00** for underground tanks. The application is attached hereto.

ITEMS REQUIRED PRIOR TO PERMIT:

- 1. Fire Sprinkler Plans, Hydraulic Calculations, Material Submittals and Third Party Peer Review of Calculations.**

- 2. Payment for Sprinkler Inspections**
 - a. \$230.00 If reviewed by Superior Fire Protection (this includes two (2) inspections and Plan Review)**
 - b. \$150.00 If reviewed by other certified company (this is for two (2) inspections, plan review must be paid to review company)**

- 3. Propane Permit (if applicable)**

- 4. Propane Permit Payment ALL propane installations must be inspected prior to burial of tanks.**
 - a. \$150.00 Above Ground**
 - b. \$250.00 Buried**

- 5. Site Plan with length, grade and width of driveway**
